



## GRADING SYSTEM

Exams are done in written form. However, with the decision of the relevant board, the studies, applications or assignments made during the semester may replace the written exam.

Success in a course is determined by the course grade. The course success grade is calculated using the relative evaluation method based on the raw success grade of the course.

The raw success grade of a course is determined by adding 40% of the midterm exam grade of the student and 60% of the final exam or make-up exam.

The expansion and coefficients are converted into one of the specified letter grades, and it becomes a course success grade.

The final exam grade of a student who cannot take the final exam due to absenteeism from a course is entered as DZ and the course success grade becomes DZ.

If the raw success grade is below 35, the course success grade will be FF.

A student who scores less than 40 in the final or makeup (resit) exam of a course will have a FF grade regardless of the midterm exam grade.
